

# **ACTIVITY**

### Tsan, Palet, Fiolet, Rebatta

## DESCRIPTION

In Valle d'Aosta, popular sports are part of local tradition and customs. Tsan, palet, fiolet and rebatta boast several centuries of history and are enjoyed by fans from all over the Valle communities, meeting on Sundays for tournaments and championships.

Palet is played in pairs with two pieces of iron (palet) and an iron jack (bollin). The game courses, 16 meters long, are built of beaten earth in squares or streets and, during winter, at the regional facility of Palafent di Brissogne or other community sites.

## TYPE Offered

Players face off individually or in teams of two or three players, with rules quite similar to bocce or "pétanques." The game begins validly if the jack tossed by a player falls into the part of the field marked for this purpose; the same player launches his or her first "palet," then a competitor launches one, attempting to come as close as possible to the jack; the farthest one launches another "palet," and so on until none are left. The team that has cast the "palet" closest jack earns points in numbers equivalent to the 'palet" closest to the jack compared with the better placed "palet" of the other team. The team that is first to reach the pre-established points (13 for the individual games, and 21 for teams).
